HEATING UPDATE – Following the PCC's approval to fund works to provide additional electrical capacity for an extra 'blower' and to purchase two new 'blowers,' David Sharples, with help from James Rolls (the Diocese's Net Zero Carbon Officer), has accelerated a grant application to cover the costs. In the meantime one heater has been ordered, and should arrive shortly. Please continue to bear with us as we work through this process in the months ahead.

BUILDING PROJECT APPEAL UPDATE – a big thank you to everyone who completed our Community Survey for our National Lottery Heritage bid. Our Building Oversight Group (chaired by Stephen Cole) is putting together our application 'tome' for the end of February.

In the meantime we are advised to press on with our separate applications for Grant and Trust funding from other national bodies. This is for **both** buildings (St Marys' House and Church) because, without modernisation and development of St Mary's House e.g. like Quay Street Church), our community outreach and mission will stop!
