**NEW ELECTORAL ROLL** - In 2025 a completely new church electoral roll has to be prepared from scratch.

The Church Electoral Roll is a register of the lay members of the church who are entitled to vote at the Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM), and those on the Roll are eligible to be elected to lay representative positions on their Parochial Church Council (PCC) and Deanery Synod. Deanery Synod representatives may then be elected to Diocesan Synod and General Synod.

It also shows:

To be entered on the new roll, we must ask you, please, to complete an application form and return it on paper or via email as follows:

All completed applications should be returned as soon as possible, and **by Easter Sunday** (20th April) at the very latest. No further applications may be accepted after this date, and the new roll will be displayed from:

- Tuesday 22nd April Woodbridge, and
- Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> April Great Bealings

in advance of our separate APCMs on:

- Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> May Woodbridge
- Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> May Great Bealings

### THOUGHT FOR THE WEEKS AHEAD

"It helps from time to time to remember that the word 'liturgy' which we use for our formal worship actually means 'the people's work' – quite literally something we make together, in the unity of Christ's Body. We're not slaves, says Jesus in John's Gospel, because slaves don't know what's going on in the master's mind; we're called to be friends together, bound by one project in which we all have a distinctive share. The great twentieth-century Russian saint and martyr, Mother Maria Skobtsova, used to like to talk about how the liturgy – so to speak – leaked out of the church door, inseparable from the common work, the shared making, that we should be engaged with in every area of our lives."
